

 Bare feet should not slip on the mat but materials such as clothes should be able to slip.



- The presenter must provide the authorized Judo mats






For Small Theater







■ ② BACKSTAGE

• DRESSING / MANAGEMENT SPACE:

1 dressing rooms, a room should have 7~8 dancers.

All equipment with sufficient tables, chairs, mirrors (at least 1full length mirror per dressing room), and costume racks.

Rest rooms (not to be shared with the public) with showers required.

2 Hangers (any type).

WARDROBE

1 iron, 1 ironing board, steamer, sewing machine (for light repairs)

Daily laundry of costumes from 1st day of setup

• OFFICE ROOM for COMPANY DIRECTOR / MANAGER / DESIGNERS:

Equipped with copier, printer and Internet line or wireless LAN requested.

Lockable space for valuables and props is required.

■ BACKSTAGE

HOSPITALITY

Bottled water necessary for all rehearsals and performances

Sinks with hot and cold running water, and non-public access toilets and showers nearby.

Towels for each dancers.

• Simple hospitality required for whole company:

Coffee & tea service, soft drinks, orange juice, fruit baskets (season fruits), vegetable platters, crackers, cookies, and other light snacks.

HEAT & COOLING:

Stage and dressing areas must be properly heated or air conditioned to not less than 72 degrees F (22c) and not more than 80 degrees F (26c).

SECURITY

Security personnel must be present to protect the safety & privacy of personnel and belongings.
